
Destroy mosquito breeding sites around your home every 2-7 days

- Check for and collect trash in the yard, especially cans, plastic bins and old tires that hold water.
- Replace or drain water in plant saucers, bird baths and water features.
- · Ensure rain gutters are draining
- Remove standing water.
- Check that chlorine content of pools and hot tubs is at upper limit of normal.
- Spray residual insecticide in and around screen doors and entranceways (where mosquitoes loiter).



- Change water in pet dishes.
- Change water in wading pools.
- Check that trash containers are covered; consider insecticide spray for wet trash between pickup.
- Reduce lawn sprinkler use so water soaks into ground and does not stand for over 1 day.
- Place fine mesh screen covers over water tanks, gutter rain barrels and other outdoor water storage.





First wash skin and hair


repellent on your hands and then apply

Step 6




Always wash hands after using repellent

To avoid mosquito bites, don't:

- Mear dark clothes
- * Wear clothes with flowers
- Use soap that smells like flowers
- Muse perfume
- Wear shorts & short sleeves
- * Walk outside with bare feet

Where mosquitoes prefer to bite



To prevent mosquito bites, do:

- Tuse repellent
- Thower or bathe every day
- Use unscented antibacterial soap
- Wear clean clothes and socks
- Wear light color clothes
- Wear long sleeve shirts and pants
- Use screens, ceiling fans & AC
- Tuse bed nets day & night
